As we come to the end of a busy and exciting season, we are happy to report that the Chyulu hills continue to get greener and the rains keep coming. The landscape is looking stunning and the horses are delighted to be approaching their annual holiday, in April and May, with so much lush grazing available.

In March we welcomed four new horses to Ride Kenya. One of the new horses is a show jumping stallion, and we are looking forward to working with him, and breeding him later down the line. The stallion was foaled at a stud down in Namibia. Both of his parents were registered Dutch warmbloods which were imported from Holland to Namibia 12 years ago. The other offspring that they have produced have proven to be fantastic competition horses. The next year at least will see Patrick training our stallion up to be a top jumping horse and safari horse, and then we hope to begin breeding him with some thoroughbreds here in Kenya.

With blood lines like his, we hope that our new stallion will project this same quality and athleticism onto future foals here in Kenya.

The other three horses that we bought are thoroughbreds from Kenya and Tanzania, which will help to supplement our current safari team and offer fast and athletic rides for our experienced guests.
