

USA - ARIZONA - TOMBSTONE MONUMENT RANCH

ITINERARY

The nearest airport is Tucson International Airport, which is one and a half hours by road from the ranch.

A rental car is recommended although transfers to and from the airport or hotels in Tucson can be arranged for you at additional cost.

Phoenix is approximately a two hour drive from Tucson. There is a local shuttle bus company ('Arizona Shuttle'), which runs between Phoenix and Tucson and we can then arrange transfers for you from Ina Road, Tucson. For more information on timetables and tickets see: www.arizonashuttle.com

If you prefer to self-drive, we will provide you with directions.

If you wish to ride on your first day, you should arrive at the ranch by 2pm for the ride safety briefing and the ride departing at 3pm. Rooms are available from 2pm.

There is no set itinerary at the ranch however the daily pattern is normally as follows; the first ride starting in the morning (c. 07:00 in summer months and c. 09:00 in winter/spring) followed then by further rides going out at c.11:00 and 15:00.



Typically rides go out two or three times a day, lessons can be arranged (at an additional cost) and there is the opportunity to try Team Penning in the arena most weeks.



The riding is flexible and the only arrangement you need to make on the evening prior is to book your first ride of the day so they know how many horses to tack up. From then onwards during the day you can do as little or as much as you like.

There is also usually the opportunity to ride into Tombstone once during the week.



Tombstone Ranch was purpose built as an 1880's Main Street with dirt roads and boardwalks.



There are 18 spacious guest rooms that are individually decorated in turn-of-the-century style. Each one is unique and you may find yourself waking up in the Mining Office, Miss Kitty's Bordello, or the Blacksmith's Shop.
