

# White Stallion Ranch, Arizona

## Itinerary

There is no set itinerary at the ranch, however the daily pattern is normally as follows; the first ride starting in the morning (around 07:00 in summer months and around 08:30/09:00 in winter/spring) followed then by further rides going out at around 11:00, 14:00 and 16:00. Typically rides go out four times a day, lessons start from 10:30 and on Monday, Wednesday and on Friday Team Penning is arranged in the arena.

The riding is flexible and the only arrangement you make on the evening prior is to book your first ride of the day, so the wranglers know how many horses to tack up. From then onwards during the day you can do as little or as much as you like.

Riding is offered six days of the week: mountain rides, slow walking rides, faster loping rides, beer and cheetos rides (adults only), sunset rides and all day rides, as well as informal instruction periods (extra charge applies –payable locally). Sunday is the horses' day off!

Weekly rodeos and hayrides are also part of the programme.
