

Between The Rivers, Iceland

Itinerary

Monday

You will be transferred to Kálfhóll farm to meet the farmers and staff.

After lunch and an introduction to the Icelandic horse and its special gaits you will have a relaxing afternoon ride.



Dinner and overnight at Blesastaðir Guesthouse. Here you can relax in the outdoor hot tub before getting a good night's sleep ready for the next day. (Approx. 15 km)

Tuesday

Please note that the following itinerary may be subject to change due to local conditions.

Leave Blesastaðir and return to the horses. From here you ride along pleasant trails to Þjórsá, a glacier fed river, stopping for a relaxed lunch on the way.



Today is a perfect way to get to know your horse and the Icelandic way of trail riding better.

Dinner and overnight at Blesastaðir Guesthouse. (Approx. 20 km)

Wednesday

Today you ride to the River Hvítá known locally as the white river.

The Hvítá river begins at the Hvítárvatn glacier lake on the Langjökull glacier. The river flows for 40 km before dropping down into a narrow gorge at the famous Gullfoss waterfall.



Along the way you follow good riding tracks, through lava and moss with amazing mountain views of the Hekla volcano.

Dinner and overnight at Blesastaðir Guesthouse. (Approx. 20 km)

Thursday

Today is your last day of riding. Return once again to Kálfhóll Farm. Today's ride leads you to the horses' summer pastures and see the mares and foals.



Your ride takes you along the riverside of Þjórsá which is the longest river in Iceland, through fertile farmlands and on excellent riding trails. (Approx. 20 km).

Return back to the stables of Kálfhóll Farm where you say goodbye to your guides and horses. The transfer arrives back in Reykjavik at about at 18:00.

Accommodation

You stay in farmhouse accommodation.

At Blesastaðir guesthouse you stay in two to four person rooms, with made up beds. Bathrooms are shared; there are three showers and three toilets. There is a hot tub at this guesthouse and WiFi is available.
