

Riding Wild Safari, Kenya

Itinerary

This trip takes place on Borana Conservancy and Il Ngwesi Group Ranch; both are home to black and white rhino and offer opportunities for great game viewing and challenging riding. The seven night mobile safari features a mix of fly camping and luxury lodges.

Day 1

Arrive in Nairobi and transfer by light aircraft to Lewa Downs airstrip where you are met and transferred to Borana Lodge. Meet your guides for a briefing on the week ahead.

Overnight at Borana Lodge.



Day 2

Meet your horses and have an introductory ride over Borana Conservancy. After lunch you may choose to ride again or perhaps take part in conservation activities such as tracking rhino on foot and helping with evening ranger deployments, walk or simply relax by the pool.

Overnight at Borana Lodge.



Day 3

Today you cross Borana Conservancy to the first fly camp, with some fun riding and game viewing on the way.

Overnight at fly camp.



Days 4 & 5

The trail leaves Borana Conservancy and takes you across to Il Ngwesi Group Ranch and Il Ngwesi Eco Lodge where you will stay for the next two nights. Il Ngwesi is an eco-lodge which is owned and run by the local Maasai community. It is at the heart of an incredibly important eco-system which borders Borana Conservancy.

From Il Ngwesi you can choose to ride or join guides on a bush walk.

Day 6

You leave Il Ngwesi Eco Lodge and cross back into Borana Conservancy. Spend the day riding through the

Mukogo Forest, where the elusive forest elephant live, until you reach your fly camp for another night under the stars.

Overnight at fly camp.



Day 7:

The final day's riding takes you back across the conservancy to Borana Lodge. In the evening you can choose to have a final ride, game drive or walk and take part in the "behind the scenes" of conservation.



Day 8

You are transferred to Lewa Downs airstrip for your flight to Nairobi.
