

# Ranch Stay, Montana

## Itinerary

Your first afternoon will be an introduction to the horses and an orientation ride. Thereafter there is no set itinerary and each week at the ranch is different depending on the wishes of the guests and the weather.

Generally breakfast is at 8:30 and you ride out about 9.30. You are welcome to get up earlier to help the family with work on the farm or tacking up the horses but it is not expected of you.



Usually you ride for three to four hours after breakfast returning to the ranch for lunch. When moving cattle the rides may be up to seven hours with a picnic lunch and there are one or two all-day trail rides with picnics, but on most days you have lunch back at the ranch.



In the afternoon you can enjoy any of the other outdoor activities such as fishing, gold panning, scenic or historical tours, hiking, ranch activities or swimming.

Dinner is around 6pm in the evening and later you may get chance to go in a 4wd for wildlife viewing.
