

Ranch Stay, Montana

Itinerary

Your first day will be an opportunity to meet the horses and have an orientation. Thereafter there is no set itinerary and what happens each week depends on the guests staying; their riding abilities; the weather and what else is going on.

Rides normally range from two to six hours in length and usually set out each morning at about 10:30. Sometimes you stay out all day with a picnic lunch; and other days you return to the ranch for lunch. In the afternoon, instead of riding out you might spend time doing some groundwork with your horse in the arena.

Between April and October ranch stays are six nights; arriving on Sunday. It is also possible to stay for ten nights or two weeks, although there are no organised activities and only simple meals provided at the weekend. Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning are free for you to hike or perhaps visit a local area of interest. You will ride on the Sunday afternoon when newly arrived guests are having their orientation. Outside of these months you may arrive and depart on any day.



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
