

Skeleton Damara, Namibia

Itinerary

Day 1

Be met on arrival at Windhoek airport. Your first night is spent in guesthouse accommodation in Windhoek.

Meet the rest of your riding group for dinner. A Namibia Horse Safari Company representative will brief the group about what to expect during the adventure ahead.

Overnight at River Crossing, (PO Box 97448, Windhoek. Tel: +264 61 401 494).



The following is a sample itinerary to be used as a rough guideline of how the trip might pan out. You could ride for up to 8 hours and cover up to 20-50km a day. However, this is an exploratory-style ride so the route, overnight stops and hours in the saddle can change.

Day 2

Leave Windhoek and transfer to the start of the ride. You travel for about four hours to have lunch in Swakopmund. You then travel a further three hours to the camp, stopping to see the Cape Cross Fur Seal Colony on the way.

Dinner and overnight in camp.

Days 3-8

There is an easy rhythm to camp life, making new friends, spending memorable evenings around the campfire and sleeping out under the stars.



Journey on horseback from the Ugab River to Leeuwkop, in this landscape of undulating, multicoloured and interesting geology.



You will find some of the best going anywhere on the planet - so expect lots of faster riding!



Day 9

Descend into the lower reaches of the Ugab River, before reaching the lichen-covered coastal plains of the Skeleton Coast.



Your last night will be spent at a house near the beach in Henties Bay.

Day 10

After breakfast say goodbye to your guides and the staff who have helped you along the way. Transfer from the end of the ride to Windhoek. Flights should depart 15:00 or later.
