

PORTUGAL - ALCAINCA - RIDING HOLIDAY

ITINERARY

We can arrange transfers from the nearest airport (Lisbon). Or you may prefer to hire a car and self-drive, which is recommended if you wish to explore widely. The journey time is approximately 30 minutes from Lisbon airport.

Check-in to your room is in the afternoon. The recommended latest arrival time is 18:00 so that you can settle into your room before dinner. There is no discount for later arrival.

Lunch is included on your departure day and it may be possible for you to have your final lesson that morning. You may need to vacate your room before lunch so that it can be made ready for arriving guests.

Please note there is no riding available on Sundays.

Check-in is usually after lunch. If you arrive earlier you are welcome to relax in the public areas, or perhaps watch lessons. You may need to vacate your room before lunch on your departure day.



The lead instructor at Alcainca is Mario Cardoso, but you may find you also ride with another teacher during your stay.



Lessons take place in the indoor school, or in the outdoor arena. They are usually 45-60 minutes in length and are conducted on a group basis (maximum 3 riders).



There are five bedrooms at Alcainca, each with an ensuite shower or bath.



Three guest rooms have twin beds and two have a double bed. As is common in many parts of Europe if you have requested a double bed, this may be created by pushing two single beds together, although the beds may still be made up with two sets of linen.



The rooms are simply decorated, clean and comfortable with air conditioning / heating units. These can be a little tricky to operate, so you should ask for help with the settings if you are not familiar with using them.

The dining room overlooks the indoor arena. There is also a riders' lounge and a large outdoor unheated pool, which is open all year.



You will be transferred to Lisbon airport.
