

Camp Davidson, South Africa

Itinerary

From Camp Davidson you can enjoy early morning and late afternoon rides through the reserve, following trails perfect for mixed pace riding.

You may even have the opportunity to experience a full day ride to a neighbouring reserve with lunch out on the trail.

During your rides you are likely to see a variety of game including include species such as giraffe, zebra, hippo, impala, eland, kudu, caracal, jackal and warthog. There are also over 300 species of birds recorded in the area.



Enjoy a final morning ride and brunch.

On your departure day: You may have to vacate your room after breakfast so that it can be made ready for arriving guests.

Accommodation

Stay in decked canvas tents nestled amongst the sandstone ridges overlooking grassy valleys. Each tent is appointed as it would have been in Ted's day with classic items that would have been essential to the traveller accustomed to regular nights in the bush. The A-frame tents have beds, sheets and duvets. Each tent also has an ensuite bathroom area with bucket showers. There are jug and basin hand wash facilities and flushing toilets.



The camp has its own plunge pool, with wonderful views of the bushveld beyond. Take a dip and then recline in one of the sun-loungers – perfect way to relax after a long day in the saddle.
