

# Horizon Lodge, South Africa

## Itinerary

There is no set itinerary and the riding is tailored to suit you. The rides are kept small with rarely more than eight guests. Guests can also be taken out on their own if requested. On a typical day set out after breakfast on an early morning ride. Return to the lodge in time for lunch.



Early afternoon you may wish to relax, cool off in the pool or a go for a walk in the surrounding bushveld. Once the heat of the day has subsided, have afternoon tea and set off for a late afternoon ride.

Rides depart early morning and late afternoon, following trails through the reserve.

Wildlife you are likely to see on the reserve include giraffe, zebra, hippo, impala, eland, kudu, caracal, jackal and warthog. There are also over 300 species of birds recorded in the area.



Depending on the presence of the hippo in the dam, there may be the chance to swim with your horse.

### **Camp Davidson**

From Camp Davidson you can enjoy early morning and late afternoon rides through the reserve, following trails perfect for mixed pace riding.

There may also be a full day ride to a neighbouring reserve with lunch out on the trail.

On your departure day: You may have to vacate your room after breakfast so that it can be made ready for arriving guests.
