

# SOUTH AFRICA - HORIZON LODGE

## ITINERARY

There is no set itinerary at Horizon and the riding is tailored to suit you. The rides are kept small with rarely more than eight guests. On a typical day you set out after breakfast on an early morning ride and return to the lodge in time for lunch.

Early afternoon you may wish to relax, cool off in the pool or go for a walk in the surrounding bushveld. Once the heat of the day has subsided, have afternoon tea and set off for a late afternoon ride.



Polocrosse is a popular activity at Horizon

Rides depart early morning and late afternoon, following trails through the reserve.

Wildlife you are likely to see at Horizon include giraffe, zebra, hippo, impala, eland, kudu, caracal, jackal and warthog. There are also over 100 species of birds recorded in the area.

Horizon Lodge overlooks a lake with a backdrop of open bushveld. The large colonial veranda (stoep) provides the perfect spot for relaxing with a drink and absorbing the beautiful surroundings. There is also a swimming pool.

The rooms at Horizon are located throughout the gardens. Some rooms are individual chalets, others adjoin the main lodge. All have en-suite or private bathrooms.
