Itinerary

Sunday

Arrive at the ranch from 2pm. Settle into your room and take time to meet your hosts and guides and your fellow guests for the week. There are ranch tours followed by cocktail hour at 6.30pm and dinner at 7pm.

On Monday morning there is a mandatory orientation for all guests who are riding (with the exception of guests who have visited recently). There is a horsemanship orientation and then you are mounted on your horse and participate in a riding orientation in the arena followed by a short ride.

Over the next five days you will be able to enjoy a wide variety of half day and all day trail rides such as:

The Painted Hills: On this half day ride you ride through sage brush and grass prairies to an area which Native Indians called 'The Painted Hills'. These are a collection of hills, brightly coloured due to the large quantities of ancient mineral found in the soil.



Mollycropsy: This is a ride for those seeking high adventure. Sharp turns, steep inclines and daring drops lead you towards a mesmerizing canyon, the home to an abundance of wildlife. This ride challenges even the most advanced rider.

Copman's Tomb: One of the most popular rides from the lodge, this trail takes you to the top of Copman's Tomb, a spectacular rock which is visible from the lodge. From the top you will have mesmerizing views and on a clear day you can see all the way to the Rockies and Yellowstone National Park.



High Desert and Canyons: These rides range in elevation from 1,280m to 1,650m through the open prairies, juniper trees and rocky canyons found within the valleys. On this ride you will find refreshing creeks and century old cottonwood trees which offer you and your horse some well-deserved shade.



Black Mountain: This breath-taking route takes you from the high desert flats of Trapper Creek, through winding fields of salt sage and ends with dramatic views over the Bighorn Basin and parts of Yellowstone National Park.
